- ✓ Document religious and community involvement by nomination letter by community leader
- ✓ Five hundred to eight hundred word essay explaining why you should be awarded scholarship
- ✓ Demonstrate financial needed, and/or student with diverse cultural experience

Jan Marie Carroll Bicentennial Scholarship

- ✓ Undergraduate or Graduate student
- ✓ Any IU campus or center
- ✓ Minimum GPA 3.3
- ✓ Any major (exception: non-general studies degree)
- ✓ May demonstrate financial need, and/or student with diverse cultural experience

James Fielding LGBTQ+ Student Advocacy & Leadership Scholarship

- ✓ Undergraduate or Graduate student
- ✓ Enrolled on the Bloomington campus
- ✓ Developing, hosting or attending leadership development event or advocacy training in support of LGBTQ+ issues
- ✓ Demonstrate attendance of event, or advocacy training contributes to degree completion

Wilma A. and Charles E. Harry, IV Family Scholarship

- ✓ Undergraduate student
